These admission procedures are in accordance with Illinois law. The law requires that programs not having sufficient space and resources to accommodate all applicants will accept those applicants best qualified, using rank, ability and achievement test scores as guides, with preference given equally to students residing in the district or in a joint agreement district.

Applicants having the same number of total points will be ranked by the date on which **All Required Paperwork** was received in the Kaskaskia College Office of Admissions. All documents must be submitted by January 31 to be considered for the first acceptance date. Students completing applications/requirements after January 31 will be considered for acceptance after May 31. Other applicants will be notified of acceptance as openings occur.

The student's health must allow the fulfillment of the requirements and objectives of the Dental Assisting Program. Each student is required to have a satisfactory physical and dental examination prior to admission. All physician forms must be turned in by September 15th.

Health forms will be distributed at a mandatory orientation, which each in-coming student will be required to attend.

All students will be required to have a drug screening at the program Coordinator's request.

Must have placement in English 101. Placement is determined by one of the following:

- ACT English score of 18 or higher within last 5 years
- SAT Evidence-Based Reading and Writing score of 480 or higher within last 5 years
- KC Writing Placement (Verbal score of 310 or higher **AND** Essay score of 3 or higher) within last 5 years
- Completion of prerequisite course English 100 with a "B" or better within last 5 years
- Completion of English 101 with a "C" or better within last 5 years
- High school cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher on an unweighted 4.0 scale within last 3 years
- GED or high school equivalency test score of 165 within last 18 months
