 •Completion of prerequisite course English 100 with a "B" or better within last 5 years  
 •Completion of English 101 with a "C" or better within last 5 years  
 •High school cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher on an unweighted 4.0 scale within last 3 years  
 •GED or high school equivalency test score of 165 within last 18 months

8. MATH **Must have placement in Math 102.** Placement is determined by one of the following:  
 •ACT Math score of 17 or higher within last 5 years  
 •SAT Math score of 460 or higher within last 5 years  
 •KC Math Placement (ALEKS score of 14 or higher) within last 5 years  
 •Completion of MATH 101 with a "C" or better within last 5 years  
 •High school cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher on an unweighted 4.0 scale with successful completion of 4th year of math within last 18 months
