McKendree University Instructional Delivery – Face to Face

McKendree University Residency – Students must complete a minimum of 30 credit hours with McKendree University.

Transfer Credits – McKendree University will accept a maximum of 90 hours in transfer credits. Only courses with a grade of C or better will be transferred.

Degree Requirements – Students must complete a minimum of 120 credit hours to receive a bachelor's degree from McKendree University. Some programs require additional hours. Elective hours required at McKendree University may vary depending on total hours accepted in transfer. All coursework at the 500 level or higher must be completed with a grade of B or better.
