All applied communication studies majors are required to choose a minor course of study and complete ACS 200, 329, 330, 409 or 424 or 415 (depending on track), in addition to the below track requirements:

Track Option: Public Relations Required Courses: ACS 213, 312, 313, 315, 413, 414, 415* plus two elective courses

Recommended electives: ACS 201, 203, 204, 210, 300, 303, 304, 305, 311, 331, 370, 403, 416, 421, 430, 431, 432, 433, 434, 491

Track Option: Corporate and Organizational Communication Required Courses: ACS 203, 300, 303, 304, 403, 409* plus three elective courses

Recommended electives: ACS 201, 204, 210, 213, 305, 311, 323, 331, 370, 416, 421, 430, 431, 432, 433, 434, 491

Track Option: Interpersonal Communication Required Courses: ACS 201, 323, 421, 422, 424*, 434, plus three elective courses
